# School Board Member Jim Green came to discuss and answer questions regarding the upcoming bond vote. Here are some highlights from what was discussed.

-This upcoming vote will include the election of three new board members

-The details of what will be covered if the bond vote passes. (See the Linn-Mar website for details or graphics in the lobby at school)

-Linn-Mar is a growing district. Current enrollment is 7,400 students. Expected growth is 8,000 by 2020. Currently every class size k-12 is over 500 students.

-The bond vote needs 60% yes to pass. Everyone please come out and vote YES!!!!

### Some Questions that were asked by meeting attendees:

Q-What's the contingency plan if the bond vote does not pass? A-Squeezing kids into classrooms and portable classrooms. The earliest the district could come back with a new plan is 6 months. With the current plan the hope is to open the new 5/6 buildings Fall 2019.

Q-Is there a phase 2 of expanding the high school?

A- Pressure is on the expanding elementary right now. The LRC building is being used to relieve some pressure on the high school overflow and Admin offices could be moved out in the future to make more room.

Q- Regarding the board member vote, who's who?

A- Look on the Facebook page to see the 6 candidates running. There is also a video from the Marion chamber of commerce on you tube and a link on the gazette.

Q-What is the structure going to be of the 5/6 building? More like an elementary school or middle school?

A-That is to be determined but most likely more like elementary

Q-will there be play equipment? A-Yes

Q-Are there plans for before and after school at the 5/6 building? A- Unknown

Q-What will the new bus routes be? A- The LRC is working on that

Q-What are the times and location of the polls? A-There are 3 places to vote

- 3. Knights of Columbus

Q-Do you have to be a citizen to vote? A-You have to be eligible to register to vote.

## PRINCIPALS REPORT

Thank you to all of the volunteers that help make the first week of school go smoothly! We have had a great start to the year with 114 new students and 2 new busses. This has been an exciting year with the addition of new teachers from Echo Hill, a new first grade teacher and new support staff. It has brought us out of our comfort zone but has been one of the best starts of school in many years as an administrator.

#### Some questions asked to Mr. Rogers were:

Q-How is the new lunch rotation going? A-So far running very smooth

Q-Are we planning on opening the gate on the parking lot to the neighborhood behind Westfield? A-No only for emergencies or if child pickup gets too crowded in the future. Also reflectors will be added to the gate.

## TREASURER REPORT

Our starting bank balance after audit was \$12,084.99 Our total budget is \$25,367.50

Last year we budgeted for an additional 100 students added at Westfield. The actual number was 114 so we will be over budget for field trips and roller-skating.

We have earned \$12,200 so far with our Write one For Westfield campaign!! Great job so far to the 122 families who have donated!!!! We have 350 families in attendance at Westfield no hope to raise another \$6000 (or more) before our back to school bash on Friday 9/15!!!

The PTO received a dedicated donation for the special needs room. A letter was read from Denise Spencer explaining how the funds would be used. So far \$150 was spent to create the Roar Store and the remaining funds would be used to re-stock the store. The group approved this dedicated donation.

#### STAFF/TEACHER REQUEST

An additional \$629 was requested to pay the increased cost of Raz Kids and was approved.

#### OLD BUSINESS

-We fell short on the 200 tickets needed to get the \$200 form the Kernels night. Weather was not in our favor.
